### Impressive blood lines

Master's blood-lines are impressive. His sire, Ceylon was the sire of many excellent dressage horses, like Ann Kathrin Linsenhoff's Courage, two times Olympic Team gold medal winner. Ceylon's sire, Jovial, also sired the Olympic Dressage bronze team medallist Ajax and the Olympic Eventing bronze medallist Sarajevo. Master's dam, the "Elite" graded Bellis, has produced a number of very high quality offspring and is related to many top dressage horses including Gauquin de Lully, Chapman and Chirac through her grandsire Chagall.

## International Grand Prix winner

Master 850 had a superb performance record. With Kyra Kyrklund, he won everything from the Swedish championships as a 5 and 6 year old to the World Cup qualifier in Århus 1997. He competed 21 times winning 18 of them and he was placed in the other 3! In his first season in Grand Prix he even finished 6th at the 1998 World Cup Final.

## Sire of international Grand Prix winners

Master is ranked 7th on the 2007 and 2008 World Breeding Ranking for dressage sires and has been awarded "Sire of the Year 2008" by the Swedish Warmblood Studbook.

At the 2008 CDI in Wiesbaden Max and Kyra won the Freestyle final where 3 of the 15 horses were by Master.

Many of Master's offspring are now performing in the international

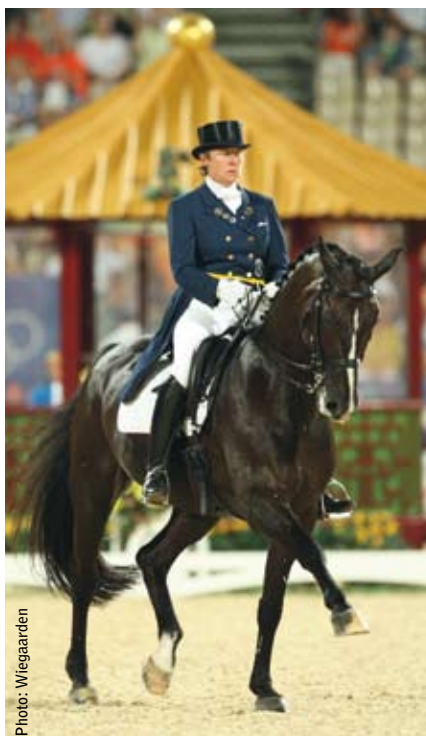

dressage arena. Max was 6th in the freestyle final and 8th overall and the highest placed Swedish Warmblood (in all disciplines) at the 2008 Olympic Games in Hong Kong. He was 4th in 2007 and 3rd in 2008 at the World Cup finals. Max is currently ranked 8th in the World. His breeder was awarded "Breeder of the Year 2008" in Sweden.

Tip Top, graded stallion, was team bronze medal winner at the World Equestrian Games 2006 with his rider Leslie Morse. They represented the US in the World Cup Final in both 2006 and 2007. Tip Top got his first stallion graded in the US last year.

## Master's young offspring excel

Apart from Tip Top, Master has four more sons graded. The youngest, Impuls, has been successful in Young Horse Championships in Sweden and at the World Young Horse Championships.

The following horses have won national championships for young horses: Maistro, Mary, Tip Top, Broadway and Impuls in Sweden, Maggie

in Denmark, Max in the UK and Hagels Marquis in Finland. With Kyra Tip Top won the Swedish championships 3 times (as a 4, 5 and 6 year old) and became the first horse to win the Young Horse Million.

Master has also produced many very good mares for the studs. The gelding Yantuge, winner of the Swedish 6-year old championships and "Champion of the Winners" at Stockholm International Horse Show, is by Blue Hors Hertug out of Damayantie by Master.

## Kyra about Master and his offspring

"Master gave me a completely new meaning and dimension to the words BALANCE, MOVEMENT and COLLECTION. The FEI rankings clearly show his ability to pass this on to his offspring.

I am always on the look-out for a new Master talent. My 7-year old Money is showing great potential and I have a feeling he is going to be like Master and Max, focused and cooperative in the big competition arenas. Last year I bought a stunning colt foal, Moritz by Master out of Polinda by Don Primaire, from Claire Skinner. It will be exciting to see if he follows in Master's footsteps too."
